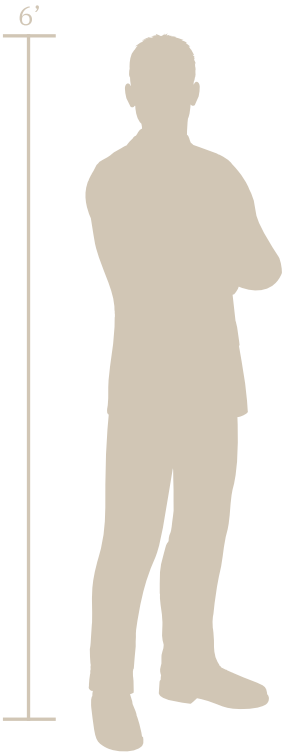


Mako<sup>©</sup> (MKO)
